How Forsa works to protect you

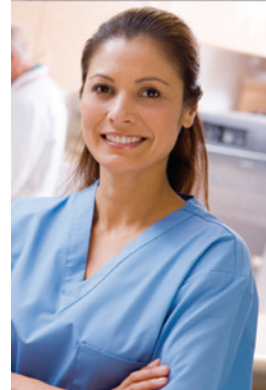
Your income: Our professional experts work to protect and improve pay and working life for Fórsa members through national and workplace agreements.
